Chairman's Report

CB reported items of interest from CPSA Board and reported:

- Shooter numbers stable, but a small migration to Clubman.
- Consideration of reduced membership costs for the unemployed.
- Root and Branch review in progress.
- An issue from the E/M skeet went to HQ from a shooter, without following the correct process of protesting to the Jury, ground, Regional Committee, Regional Director and then the CPSA. By using the hierarchy, it would be hoped that the shooter can obtain satisfaction faster and any appropriate actions without delay.

Secretary's Report

BM reported that he will stand down from the Secretary's role at 2011 AGM, due to his commitments towards the 2012 Olympics as a National Technical Officer. Bob would like to remain, if elected, as a committee member.

Treasurer's Report

MH reported a brought forward balance of £744.47, income of £82.00 from levies and expenditure of £193.05 on badges. The changes provided a carried forward balance of £633.42.

BM provided MH with £31 from the FITASC and SPT levies. This was under the level set by Northants, as Beds ran the event and charged based on their reduced current levy rate.

Action: BM to talk with Beds Chairman to review.

County Championships Reports

The Sportrap, FITASC and ABT championships have already been run and no issues. ABT was considered for 2010 to have no abacus and shoot straight through. From experiences this year, it has been proposed that from 2011, ABT be run 50 straight through (in rounds of 25) a break of 30 minutes and then back for the last 50. Proposed MH, Seconded BM. The motion was carried unanimously.
