May brings the first Northamptonshire county championships for 2010, with Sportrap and FITASC at Sporting Targets and ABT at Northampton Shooting Ground. Andrew Clifton has kindly offered to hold the first two championships, as he has the facilities to host four different SPT layouts and already hosts the Bedfordshire FITASC championships. I shot the FITASC with the Stoke Park members in 2009 and from that outing picked the county representatives for the Inter-County team. Sporting Targets shoot FITASC straight through without a break, so no waiting around to move layouts.

Northampton Shooting Ground have proposed to shoot the county ABT championships straight through for 2010. This will mean that the squads will not have to referee the following squad's shoot. The rules allow for the Assistant Referees to only be used if requested and Northampton S.G. are offering to supply the additional referees to allow shooters to do what they do best; shoot clays! Do let us know what you think of the idea.

The new committee is already working on your behalf for this, the County's 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary year. Pete Wallane has been unanimously elected as Vice Chairman, at the first committee meeting of the year, promoted from his previous post of Treasurer in 2009. Our new committee members are already adding items to the meeting agendas and looking to bring new ideas and initiatives in 2010.
